CRICKET CAMPS 2019

General Information: The Galleon is running a Cricket Camp during the first week of the Easter holidays, for children currently in P4 to S3. P4 to P7 age group will be a half day camp with S1-S4 running full days.

Both camps will provide a great opportunity for children to brush up on skills and fitness for the start of the new season. The emphasis of the courses will be on developing cricket skills, techniques and knowledge in a fun environment. All morning activities will run from the Galleon, using the Sports Halls, astroturf pitches and the front grass pitch. The afternoon sessions will be held in the same locations but may also utilise Craiglockhart pitches.

Times: P4–P7 runs from 9.00am – 12.30pm / S1 – S3 runs from 9.00am – 4.00pm

Drop-off and Collection: Drop off times are from 8.30am – 9.00am and collection from 4.00pm – 4.30pm at The Galleon reception.

If you are happy for your child to sign themselves in and/or out of the camp please tick the consent box at the end of the application form.

If you require an earlier drop-off than the allocated time, this is available from 7.45am at an additional cost of £10.

Activities: Technical, tactical and match play according to age, level of ability.

Activities: Skill drills and practices will be played as well as modified games according to age, level and ability

Refreshments: Each child must provide their own packed lunch (including a plastic bottle) and snacks for breaks.

Spaces: The Cricket Camp will be capped at 60 children and spaces will be allocated on a first come, first served basis. A space will only be allocated upon receipt of an application form.

Payment options: All GWC pupils will be charged via Extras account or by Child Care Vouchers (CCVs) for children up to the age of 16.

Non-GWC pupils will be invoiced by the School Accounts Department for payment via Bank Transfer.

Costs: Half Day = £80 for children who are members of the Galleon* and £95 for non-members

Full Day = £140 for children who are members of the Galleon* and £165 for non-members

* Children must be members of the Galleon at the time of the camps to be eligible for discounted price

Clothing/Equipment: Children are asked to wear appropriate clothing and remember warm clothes and a rain jacket, as activities might take place outside regardless of the weather. Please ensure all personal belongings are named. If possible children should bring their own equipment, but there will be some available to borrow if needed.

Staffing: Children will be split into groups according to age and experience. The ratio of staff to children will be 1:12.
