

August Rowing 2022 All You Need To Know

Mon 15 & Tues 16 August: 09:00-12:00 or 13.00-16.00 Wed 17 & Thur 18 August: 09:00-12:00 or 13.00-16.00

Spaces Available: 30 spaces max per week **Application Deadline**: 31 July 2022

Who Can Attend: The camps are open to all GWC children currently in P7 or S1.

Times: The session runs from 9.00am-12.00pm & 1.00pm - 4.00pm

Drop Off & Collection: Drop off is from 8:45am or 12.45pm and collection from 12:00pm & 4.00pm.

If you are happy for your child to sign themselves in and / or out of the camp please tick the consent box on the application form.

Registration will take place at the Craiglockhart Pavilion (off Craiglockhart Terrace) and water sessions will be conducted from the George Watson's College Boathouse (just down the hill from Craiglockhart Playing Fields). Please use the parking at Craiglockhart Playing Fields when dropping off and picking up.

Clothing / Equipment: Children are asked to wear appropriate clothing and footwear for physical activity; no loose clothing that may become caught in the boats. We advise bringing a change of clothes and a towel. A waterproof jacket and appropriate sun protection should be brought. Please ensure all personal belongings are named and not left at the end of the day.

Refreshments: Each child must provide their own water bottle and snacks for breaks.

Spaces: The camps will be capped at 30 children and spaces will be allocated on a first come, first served basis.

Booking: A space can only be allocated upon completion and submission of the online Google Application Form. A confirmation email will be sent by a Galleon team member confirming if your application is successful.

Cost: £70 for 2 days (Individual days are not available)

Payment options: The cost will be charged to your extras account or you can pay by Child Care Vouchers (CCVs) for children up to the age of 16.

Cancellation Policy: Cancellations can be made up to two weeks before the camp start date at no charge.

Next Steps:Complete the online Google Application Form and wait for an automated response acknowledging that we have received your application.

A confirmation email sent by a member of the Galleon team will follow this advising if your application has been successful.
